Policy

- Goal of the weekend: aspirant leaders learn how to lead on (big/salt) ice; leaders are there to support the aspirants and learn while skating
- Safety, evaluation, preparation and briefing are more important than skating from dawn to dusk
- Sweden/east side Norway is preferred, even when there is ice in Holland or Germany (except for 11-studentocht = cancellation of the weekend)
- All committees facilitate the leaders-of-the-day to bring them in comfort
- Leaders of the day take over when target area / next day area is known from ice finding committee
- Lodging place is decided one day in advance, all groups in the same place
- Dinner served at 19:30 for everyone, prepared per skating group
- Everyone together from 20:30 to 22:00 in one room for evaluation and next day briefings; groups listen to each other and ask questions
- Everyone together (in one room) at breakfast at 7:00 for second briefing
- Each group has freedom starting after briefing, ending before dinner
- Every day includes a safety exercise for each group, organized by the leaders
