HLSK situation 2020 - 2022

- Pre-covid, members mostly went skating in Sweden via club tours
- A few members were preparing to start doing private tours
- During covid, the wish to be independent from the club increased

- The training committee recognized the need to introduce individual training via the web, and use classroom training as support
- During 2021 and 2022, the HLSK board and training committee started working on the transformation of our education program

Which problems do we want to solve?

- The old HLSK leader and old ice fox training are not scalable
- The wait-for-next 4 year ice fox cycle raised a lot of questions
- The training committee is overloaded
- The old ice fox training was limited to ice knowledge
- The few groups that went to Sweden had problems
- The overview when to learn what is unclear

HLSK encourages private tours and wants to facilitate that with knowledge

We recognized four educational pathways

Adoption of a best practice

- We use <u>EQF</u>, the European Qualification Framework, for <u>level graduation</u>
- To solve multiple problems with the existing education, we split each level in two:
 - Aspirant study material to get at the knowledge level you want
 - Mature study material to widen and maintain your knowledge and experience

Study material

- We investigated the Nordic Skating practice and our existing materials
- Came to conclusion there are eight main subjects
- Each subject has multiple lessons

Preconditions

Equipment, clothing, websites and apps, fitness, travel stay & food

Organization

Decision system, tasks & roles, group dynamics, planning

Ice knowledge

Fresh water ice, big ice, salt ice, spring ice, ice phenomena

Weather knowledge

Weather patterns, cooling of water, frost and thaw, influence on ice

Finding skateable ice

Skridskonät, satpics, new ice, old ice, multi-day ice

Skating a tour

Patterns, pitfalls, safety, plurrning, ice drift, risk analysis

Medical matters

Medical conditions, emergency care, resonsibilities

Evaluation

Reporting tours, incident reports, improvement lists


Subject : skating a tour

Level : aspirant ice fox

example

- Each subject has material on multiple levels
- Web page includes link(s) to same subject on previous and next level
- Each lesson of each subject should be concluded with a test
- Test can be online (theory) or on the ice (practice with a leader)

The tests are in line with Bloom's Taxonomy



Bloom's Taxonomy is useful for teachers when making material. For instance aspirant ice foxes need to apply the content of the material you design, so keep that in mind when creating material.
